Every engine we sell meets all the criteria of original equipment standards at a cost that offers you substantial savings. Plus, we back up our product with a written warranty – 6 years Australia wide (including BOTH parts and labour) if serviced by QFES (private use). There are **no kilometer limits** or any fine print, just a fair dinkum hassle-free engine warranty.

Here's how we do it. Engine blocks, crankshafts and other heavy parts normally don't wear out. After thorough cleaning and inspection, we keep only those major parts that can be precision reconditioned to original equipment standards. Then we add new quality parts to complete the assembly.

Plus, your downtime will be almost nothing. Because with our size and large volume, we always have over 1,000 engines available, ready for immediate fitting. And these include virtually all-domestic and light commercial engines.

With the basic service items we don't supply the cheapest parts to cut costs. The parts brands include Pennzoil, Masterpart, Ryco, NGK, Tridon and Tectaloy, all industry leaders.

Radiator inhibitor is vital for the internal protection of your engine. We put **twice the minimum requirement** to ensure excellent protection from internal corrosion, sure it costs us a bit more but it's a little price to pay for your long-term satisfaction.

All ancillary items go through a **thorough 173-point check**. Ancillary items are hoses, belts, engine mounts, clutch etc the things that bolt onto the engine. If any ancillary items are suspect I will give you a call first with a price before any extra parts are fitted. Items that may be suspect are such things as drive belts and cooling hoses. There are **no extra labour charges** just the price of the parts if any.

We offer a FREE pick up service in the Brisbane area. We have supplied and fitted a lot of engines around your area if you would like to talk to some of our clients let me know and I could arrange that with them.

10 Question YOU should ask before getting your engine replaced.

- 1. Ask to see their public risk and road testing of customer's vehicle insurance cover.**
What if someone has an accident in your car while it is getting repaired? Most car insurance doesn't cover this type of claim. This could be very costly if you're not properly protected.
- 2. Ask to see their business registration or their Australian business number.**
Registrations and ABN's help to keep out the fly-by-niters. What sometimes happen are these people start up a so called business, do bodgy work then close the shop up within a short period of time, so they don't have a repair warranty.
- 3. Do they employ qualified tradesmen?**
Tradesman mechanics and engine reconditioners undergo 4 years apprenticeship to obtain their qualifications. It's important your engine and parts are fitted by a qualified person to ensure it will be fitted, adjusted and tuned correctly.
- 4. Do they use premium parts?**
Only well known brands should be excepted with the solid backing of an established name. You get what you pay for – quality lasts
- 5. Do they guarantee their work in writing?**
Verbal guarantees are useless. Do they have a track record and will they be around to honor any guarantee.
- 6. Do they supply you with a detailed proposal setting out all the parts that are going to be replaced?**
Unfortunately the value of a well-written out proposal is often only understood after a problem develops. It's only what is written down that counts. Lack of detail leaves you with no evidence should a dispute arise.
- 7. What precautions will they take to protect your car?**
It is important that your car is protected during the work. We protect your car while its in our care against it being in any kind of an accident, fire and theft.
- 8. Ask to see references.**
Can you see references from satisfied customers or even talk to some of their not so recent jobs? It pays to see if the job was up to their standards, if the job was finished in time and if there was a problem, how did they go about getting it fixed.
- 9. Do they explain the running in period and how to get the most out of your engine?**
Correct running in and maintenance procedures are the keys to long term motoring. Try and find out what they propose to do. After your fully reconditioned engine has been installed we go through with you on how to run your engine in (very simple) and also give you a service schedule.
- 10. Do they explain what happens in the case of a warranty problem?**
What happens if you're in Melbourne and a warranty problem occurs, can you get the car fixed in any town without costing you money?

Will the price change?
